The tournament will run in four sessions to bring everyone a pleasant, easy-to-navigate experience:

1) Tots & Bantams 2) Midgets 3) Novices 4) Schoolboys & Cadets (through 8th grade only)

Schedule is as follows:

8:00 am: Building opens
9:00 am: Tots and Bantams begin
11:00 am: Midgets begin
1:00 pm: Novice begins
3:00 pm: Schoolboys and Cadets begins

<u>Coach's information</u>: AAU Cards – coaches must have AAU cards PRINTED OUT and on a lanyard. This is a new AAU policy and we will be enforcing it. No cards on phones will be allowed. AAU Age Divisions for 2024-25: Tot - Born 2019 and after Bantam - Born 2017 & 2018 Midget - Born 2015 & 2016 Novice - Born 2013 & 2014 Schoolboy - Born 07/01/2011-12/31/2012 Cadet - Born 2009 - 6/30/2011

Registration: On trackwrestling.com, event name is **2024 Spartan Kickoff**. The deadline for club administrators to enter club rosters is **11:59 pm Friday**, **November 29rd**. Weights submitted must be **accurate and verified** by club administrator prior to entering registrations. All participants must have a current AAU membership. AAU membership IS NOT included as part of the entry fee to the event. AAU membership must be obtained before the competition begins except where the event operator has a laptop available with an internet connect. Participants are encouraged to visit the AAU web site www.aausports.org to obtain their membership. This event is licensed by the Amateur Athletic Union of the U. S., Inc.

Cost: \$35 per wrestler. *** NEW THIS YEAR *** We will be using Trackwrestling.com for both registration as well as payment of the tournament fee. Individuals should pay their wrestling club; then the club admin should submit payment online on **Trackwrestling.com** when registering their team/wrestlers. Please note that Trackwrestling.com charges a fee of \$2 per wrestler per entry, plus a 3.15% per transaction fee for all online payments. Since payment is collected at time of registration, there will not be refunds given if a wrestler does not attend.

Format: Wrestlers in each division will be grouped by weight and experience rating. Please rate each of the wrestlers on your roster based on their experience/success level. Experience levels are the following:

4 = Beginner (<u>**first year only</u>**)</u>

- 3 = At least one year experience / fair to average / has not placed at AAU state tournament
- $2 = \text{Good} / \text{has placed 5}^{\text{th}} 6^{\text{th}}$ at AAU state tournament or qualified for USA state tournament
- 1 = Excellent / placed top 4 in AAU state tournament (blue division) or placed top 6 at USA state tournament

We will do our best to group wrestlers by experience. **Beginners are encouraged to compete and will be bracketed with other beginners. A beginner is defined as a** <u>first-year</u> wrestler.

Brackets: Brackets will consist mostly of 4- or 5-man round-robins.

Awards: Medals to top three place winners in each bracket.

Admission is free and full concessions will be available all day.
