- RULES:**
- All teams and players must be rostered and have a valid membership with AAU. Teams are required to bring their official team roster or player cards, as well as their travel permit (if required by their governing body) to each game. All teams are guaranteed four games. Teams/Officials must be ready to start games up to 15 minutes early. Rosters are frozen the first day of the tournament. A player must play at least one game prior to the quarterfinals or semifinals to be eligible to play in playoff games. Teams must be prepared to play Friday morning. Reserving a hotel room Thursday evening is advised.
- NO TOURNAMENT OFFICIAL** has the right to change a score sheet or reverse a call from a referee. Once game is over, the score sheet is **FINAL**.
- This event is sanctioned by AAU. Please refer to the USA Hockey playing rulebook for all rules for 2017-2021.
- No body checking will be permitted.
- Tag-up offsides will be played for all divisions.
- New icing rule for this tournament **WILL NOT** be in effect.
- Minor penalties - 1:30 minutes/Major penalties - 5 minutes.
- Game misconduct - Player will be ejected for the remainder of that game plus the next schedule game.
- Running-time will be in effect during the third period only when a team is winning by five-or-more goals. Stop-time will resume once the score is within two goals.
- No timeouts are permitted in preliminary rounds.
- One 30-second timeout is permitted in quarterfinals, semifinals and finals.
- Players and coaches should report to the arena at least one hour prior to each game. A maximum of four team officials may be on the players' bench at one time. The home team will wear white jerseys and visitors wear dark.
- 3-minute warm-up.
- All games will be 12-12-12 minute stop-time periods.
- If the game is tied at the end of regulation in preliminary rounds, a three-player shootout will take place.
- To determine teams advancing to the semifinal and final rounds, if more than two teams are tied, as soon as the tie is broken, the tiebreaker is reapplied to any remaining ties:
- Total Team Points**  
**Head-to-Head (two-team tie-breaker only)**  
**Goal Differential (Maximum 7-goal differential per game)**  
**Least Goals Allowed**
