ENTRY FEES: \$20.00 (Track & Field) & \$30 (Multi Events) per athlete entered online at www.coacho.com by Monday, February 21, 2022 by 11:59 p.m. The meet is open to clubs and unattached athletes. **NO LATE ENTRIES** or **MODIFICATIONS**. Fees must be paid online by the close of the meet registration.

ENTRY LIMITATIONS: 8 & under thru 11-12 divisions – 3 events. 13-14 thru 17-18 enter 4 events. Athletes who are still 18 years of age on the day of the AAU Junior Olympic National Championship Meet shall be eligible to compete in the open division.

ADVANCEMENT: Top 16 participants will advance to OZARK AAU Indoor Series CHAMPIONSHIP on FEBRUARY 26 - 27, 2022.

UNSEED SECTION: Athletes who did not advance from the January 30 and February 13 meets will be allowed to enter the meet in the unseeded section.

ENTRIES: ALL ENTRIES MUST BE COMPLETED ON-LINE BY TUESDAY, FEBRUARY 21ST BY 11:59 p.m. **ALL ATHLETES MUST HAVE A VALID AAU CARD TO PARTICIPATE.**
