- Age Groups:** Age Determination Date – 1<sup>st</sup> Day of Competition, April 12<sup>th</sup>, 2019.  
Age Divisions will be grouped by birthdate ranges per AAU National Rules. Ages 4 through ladies.
- Rules:** AAU National Rules – No District Modifications.

**Awards:** Awards are provided for each level and age division 100% in the all-around. Individual event awards are awarded to the top 50% + 1 within each age division.  
\* Club Team Awards will be awarded by using the top three scores per event per level regardless of age. You must enter the club team competition for each level to be eligible for the club team award. Any team with 3 or more per level are automatically entered and will be charged.  
\*All District State Award – Given to the highest All-Around score per level/session.

## **ALL GYMNASTS & COACHES ON COMPETITIVE FLOOR MUST BE AAU REGISTERED**

This event is licensed by the Amateur Athletic Union of the U.S., Inc. All participants must have a current AAU membership. AAU membership may not be included as part of the entry fee to the event. AAU Youth Athlete membership must be obtained before the competition begins. **BE PREPARED!** Adult and Non-Athlete memberships are no longer instant and cannot be applied for at event. Please allow at least 10 days for membership to be processed. Participants are encouraged to visit the AAU website: [www.aausports.org](http://www.aausports.org) to obtain their membership.

**Judging Rules:** This is not a USAG meet. AAU only follows USAG routine rules for guidelines. The judging is also different from USAG for some deductions. AAU follows USAG routines **with some changes**. Please see the AAU website for handbook rules at [www.aausports.org](http://www.aausports.org). Go to publications for the gymnastics handbook. Please see that some routines are different than that of USA. Wisconsin Does NOT change any routines from the AAU National rules allowed.

#### **Scratch a Gymnast:**

- 1) Make the scratch in MeetMaker.com
- 2) Email LeaAnn Bohn at [aauwigymnastics@gmail.com](mailto:aauwigymnastics@gmail.com) informing her of the scratch.  
Also, include in your email if scratching the gymnast does not give you enough for the team entry. Only notes from doctors will be excused and receive partial refund. No refunds on scratches made on day of competition.

#### **Level Change/ Correction:**

- 1) Make the change / correction in MeetMaker.com
- 2) Email LeaAnn Bohn at [aauwigymnastics@gmail.com](mailto:aauwigymnastics@gmail.com) informing her of the change / correction.

#### **Adding a Gymnast:**

- 1) Email LeaAnn Bohn to ask if there is room to still add a gymnast to get the OK to add on the registration at MeetMaker.com
- 2) Make the addition in MeetMaker.com Make sure if you have a team for that level that you are adding the gymnast to, you add to the team designation as well, .

#### **Late entry after registration date if room allows.**

- 1) Make the Late Entry in MeetMaker.com MeetMaker will tell you that your meet entry request is pending approval.
- 2) Email LeaAnn Bohn at [aauwigymnastics@gmail.com](mailto:aauwigymnastics@gmail.com) and inform her that you are wishing to enter a gymnast into the meet if room allows but it is after the registration deadline and registration has closed.
