RULES: • Head Coaches are responsible for their bench personnel, players and fans.

• Unless a modification is listed below, IDHSAA rules will be used for all games.

Timing

o Two 20-minute running halves, except for last 2 minutes of each half.

o Last 2 minutes: Clock stops on all whistles.

? Unless score differential is 20+, then continue running clock.

? If score differential drops below 20, clock stops on all whistles again.

o No shot clock.

• Overtime:

o 1st Overtime - 1 minute

o 2nd Overtime - First team to score

• Timeouts – 2 per half (no carryover); all timeouts are 1 minute. No additional timeouts for overtime periods.

• 15-minute pre-game warm-up if on schedule (will be reduced if running late).

5-minute halftimes (IF running late will be reduced to 3)

• No pressing in last 10 minutes of second half if team has 20-point lead.

• BONUS: 7 team fouls = 1-and-1; 10 team fouls = double bonus

• Technical fouls are automatic 2 points.

• Team listed first is Home Team. Home team sits to the scorekeeper's left; visiting team sits to the scorekeeper's right. Both scorekeepers need to sit at the score table. Scorekeepers MUST be impartial and professional at all times.

• Head-to-head result used to break ties between two tied teams. For ties of more than two teams, point differential is used to break ties, between tied teams ONLY. If a tie still exists, all games in division/bracket will be used.

Maximum point differential for tie-breaking criteria is 20 points.

• Winning team is responsible for submitting score to gym manager (at the gate).
