Traditional Forms: OPEN

- Brazilian Repechage Format
- Allowed patterns are defined within AAU Taekwondo Handbook under ITF, WT or TSD
- This event will be offered for all ages
- This event will be offered for all belt levels
- Judging criteria includes Beauty, Grace, Rhythm, Focus, Power, & Technique

Weapons Forms: Traditional

- Brazilian Repechage Format
- No live blades will be allowed
- Minimum one hand must remain in contact with the weapon at all times
- Inverted aerial maneuvers are not allowed
- Judging criteria includes Beauty, Grace, Rhythm, Focus, Power, & Technique

Black Belt Team Forms

- Brazilian Repechage Format
- All traditional forms accepted (ITF, WT, TSD)
- All Black Belt team forms divisions shall consist of 3-person teams
- Teams may be all male, all female or mixed
- Age groups include Under 18yo and 18 & over

Mixed Belt & Age Team Forms

- Brazilian Repechage Format
- Team MUST be comprised of both Junior and Adult members and/or include under black belt members. o (i.e. Team membership would NOT meet the requirements to compete in the existing Junior Team Forms nor Adult Team Forms divisions.)
- All traditional forms accepted (ITF, WT, TSD)

Board Breaking: Repetitive Spin Hook

- Single break format; One board per strike See Board Sizes Below
- Allowed technique is spinning hook kick
- 10 board competition
- Winner based on time required to break 10 boards

Board Breaking: Repetitive Side Kick

- Single break format; One board per strike See Board Sizes Below
- Allowed technique is side kick
- 10 board competition
- Winner based on time required to break 10 boards

Board Breaking: Repetitive Hand Technique (Feeder System)

- Single break format; One board per strike See Board Sizes Below
- Allowed technique is hammer fist, palm, knife or fist (punch)
- 10 board competition
- Winner based on time required to break 10 boards

· All special needs forms & board breaking divisions

- Black belts = Three 1:00min rounds
- KPnP electronic scoring for 10yrs and older Black Belts
