Events are open to all age groups and Master's (19+) swimmers.

We will have mixed relays (2 boys and 2 girls). Heats will be mixed gender and pre-seeded.

Sanction: AAU Event Code:

- This event is licensed by the Amateur Athletic Union of the U.S., Inc.
- All participants must have a current AAU membership which may not be included as part of the entry fee to the event.
- AAU **Youth** athlete membership must be obtained before the competition except where the event operator has a laptop with an Internet connection.
- **Be prepared: Adult and Non-Athlete memberships are no longer instant and cannot be applied for at an event. Due to background screenings, please allow up to 10 days for the adult memberships to be processed.**
- Participants are encouraged to visit the AAU website www.aausports.org to obtain their membership.
- **Note: any contacts listed within this flyer MUST have a current AAU membership.**

Location: Perry Park Center, 800 City Park Drive, Perryville, MO 63775

Date/Time: **Saturday, February 8, 2025 with 8:00 a.m. start time.** Please enter through pool gate and doors which will be open by 6:45 a.m. **Entry is limited to locker rooms and pool area only.**

Warm-up: Time and Lanes to be determined based on number of swimmers

Facility: 25-meter short course, 6 lanes, Colorado Timing System with touch pads and plunger. The 2nd and 4th swimmers in the 100-meter relays need to start in the water because of the pool depth. All events will start from the blocks. Two plungers and stopwatches will be used at the turn end of the pool for 25-meter events.

Eligibility: AAU registered athletes. The age of the swimmer as of **Saturday, February 8, 2025**, will be the athlete's competition age.

Ages: 8 & under, 9-10 years, 11-12 years, 13-14 years, 15-18 years, & Masters 19+

Relays (mixed includes 2 boys & 2 girls): 10 & under (100 m), 18 & under and Masters 19+ (200 m), 100 mixed relay and mixed club relay (10 & under) and 200 mixed relay and mixed club free relay (all ages)

Officials: Officials are welcome and needed. **Officials meeting at 7:30 a.m. outside the side pool door or in hallway.**

- Timing:** Colorado Timing System with touch pads and plunger. Stop watches are used for back up times. Volunteers from each team will be asked to time. We will have two timers per lane.
Timer's meeting is at 7:40 a.m. outside the side pool door or in hallway.
- Coaches:** **Coaches meeting at 7:50 a.m. outside the side pool door or in hallway.**
- Events:** 25, 50, 100, and 200-meter events (in each stroke except NO 200 fly) as well as the 100 IM, 200 IM and medley relays, mixed medley relays, free relays, mixed free relays, and just for fun mixed club free relay.
- All events are TIMED FINALS
 - Submit swimmer's best SHORT COURSE METER times for proper seeding
 - All events are open to all age groups & Masters 19+
 - Over the top starts may be done for all events that are 50+ (depends on number of swimmers entered)
 - **No bull pen will be used.**
 - **Heats will be mixed gender and pre-seeded by time (all ages swim together).**
 - **100 relays 10 & under and 200 relays 18 & under and 19+**
 - **Results will be separated into age groups and gender.**
- Scoring:** Individual 9, 7, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1 and Relays 18, 14, 12, 10, 8, 6, 4, 2
- Results:** Will be posted on the wall behind the slide. Will also be available on Meet Mobile.
- Awards:** Heat winners (male and female in each heat) will be responsible for picking up their awards. Ribbons: Individual 1st-8th, and Relays 1st-4th. High point medals are awarded for 1st-3rd in each age group and gender.
- Entry Limit:** Each swimmer may swim a maximum of 5 individual events and 2 relays. Mixed relays are included in the event limit. All swimmers will be entered in the final mixed club free relay unless you tell us otherwise.
- Entries:** All teams are encouraged to enter the meet with **Hy-Tek**. **Entries** must be sent to Angie Schupp at perryvillepiranhas@gmail.com by **8:00 p.m. on Tuesday, February 4**. Please include a contact name and phone number with the entries. An e-mail that your entries were received will be sent to you. **Deck entries will only be accepted the day of the meet IF the swimmer is already registered for the meet, and IF there is an open lane. No new heats will be created.**
- Adult Entries:** 1. Join the AAU as a member at www.aausports.org. 2. If not entering with a team, please download the free Hytek Lite Software <https://hytek.active.com/downloads.html> 3. Get the event file by e-mailing www.perryvillepiranhas@gmail.com and then e-mail the completed HyTek TM file back. An e-mail that your entries were received will be sent to you or **when you email proof of your AAU membership, you can also email me the events you'd like to swim, and I can enter you into those events.**
- Entry Fee:** \$35 per swimmer. All fees are due before the start of the meet. **Please make team checks payable to: Piranha Parents.**
