- a. Age is determined by age of diver on July 31, 2022.
- b. Dives must be listed in the above order on the dive sheet.
- c. Voluntary dives are any dives of the diver's choosing with a set degree of difficulty of 1.8 on the 1-meter and 1.9 on the 3-meter. Voluntary dives must be from different dive groups (forward, back, reverse, inward and twist).
- d. Optional dives must be from different dive groups. The DD is determined by the Degree of Difficulty Table.
- e. Any skills may be used as voluntary or optional dives with D.D. = 1.0.
- f. Dives requiring the assistance of the coach will have a D.D. value of zero (0).
- g. Dives performed without an obvious attempt to jump into the air will have a D.D. = 1.0 (i.e. forward and back line-ups).
- h. No dives or skill may be repeated in the same contest. If a diver must repeat a dive, it will have a D.D. value of zero (0).
