2022 Invitational Tournament

- DATE:** Sunday, March 6, 2022
- TIMES:** Wrestling begins at 9:15 a.m. for ALL age groups (we will be wrestling in two gyms). All scratches and double-bracket requests must be made with the Head Pairer, Sarah Reynolds, by 8:15 a.m. Coaches/Officials meeting @ 8:30 a.m. Table Workers meeting at 8:45 a.m.
- LOCATION:** Billings Senior High School, 425 Grand Ave., Billings, MT; Please park and enter on the north side of the building.
- WEIGH-INS:** Honor weigh-ins to be completed Thursday evening, March 3rd. No on-site weigh-ins.
- REGISTRATION:** We will be running this tournament on the Track Wrestling system, accessible by logging on to www.trackwrestling.com. Registration must be completed on this site by selecting "Browse," then "Tournaments." Then click "Search" and input "2022 Darkhorse Invitational." Finally, click "Pre-Register" and navigate through the registration process. **Registrations must be complete by 10:00 P.M. on Friday, March 4th.** If you have any questions about the registration process, please contact sreynolds@huntley.k12.mt.us or call Sarah Reynolds (406) 698-7665.
- ENTRY FEE:** \$7 per wrestler – Payable directly through registration at www.trackwrestling.com.
- REQUIREMENTS:** Each club will be required to provide 1 adult referee and 2 table workers (including 1 Trackwrestling operator). Fines will be assessed if not provided. Trackwrestling workers, please contact Sarah Reynolds prior to the tournament so she can ensure all tables will be covered.
- ADMISSIONS:** Adults: \$7 Students: \$5 Kids 5 & Under: Free
- COACHES:** A current AAU card will be required to obtain a coach's pass, after paying \$7 admission fee.
- AWARDS:** 1st Place individual trophies; 2nd – 6th Place medals; Team trophies for Sm., Med., Large
- CONCESSIONS:** Full concessions will be available all day. No coolers please.
- SANCTION:** This event is licensed by the Amateur Athletic Union of the U.S., Inc. All participants must have a current AAU Membership. AAU membership may not be included as part of the entry fee to the event. AAU membership must be obtained before the competition begins except where the event operator has a laptop available with an internet connection. **BE PREPARED: Adult and Non-Athlete memberships are no longer instant and cannot be applied for at event. Please allow 10 days for membership to be processed.** Participants are encouraged to visit the AAU website www.aausports.org to obtain their membership.
- OTHER:** All Montana AAU standing rules apply.
