Events are open to all age groups and Master’s (19+) swimmers.

We will have mixed relays (2 boys and 2 girls). Heats will be mixed gender and pre-seeded. Fun mixed club relays too!

Sanction: AAU Event Code:

- This event is licensed by the Amateur Athletic Union of the U.S., Inc.
- All participants must have a current AAU membership which may not be included as part of the entry fee to the event.
- AAU Youth athlete membership must be obtained before the competition except where the event operator has a laptop with an Internet connection.
- **Be prepared: Adult and Non-Athlete memberships are no longer instant and cannot be applied for at an event. Due to background screenings, please allow up to 10 days for the adult memberships to be processed.**
- Participants are encouraged to visit the AAU website www.aausports.org to obtain their membership.
- **Note: any contacts listed within this flyer MUST have a current AAU membership.**

Date/Time: Saturday, September 28, 2019 with 8:00 a.m. start time.
Please enter through pool gate and doors which will be open by 7:00 a.m.
Entry is limited to locker rooms and pool area only.

Warm-up: Time and Lanes to be determined based on number of swimmers. Warm ups begin at 7:00 a.m.

Facility: 25-meter short course, 6 lanes, Colorado Timing System with touch pads and plunger. The 2nd and 4th swimmers in the 100-meter relays need to start in the water because of the pool depth. Also, the 25-meter events will start at the “shallow” end.

Eligibility: AAU registered athletes. The age of the swimmer as of Saturday, September 28, 2019, will be the athlete’s competition age.

Ages: 8 & under, 9-10 years, 11-12 years, 13-14 years, 15-18 years, & Masters 19+
Relays: Medley and free: 10 & under (100 meters), 18 & under, and Masters 19+ (200 meters)
Mixed medley and free relays- 2 boys & 2 girls (100 Meters 10 & U and 200 Meters 11+)
Mixed club free relays- (Just for fun...100 Meters 10 & U and 200 Meters 11+)

- Officials:** Officials are welcome and needed. **Officials meeting at 7:30 a.m. at the computer table.**
- Coaches:** **Coaches meeting at 7:45 a.m. by the baby pool.**
- Timing:** Colorado Timing System with touch pads and plunger. Stop watches are used for back up times. Volunteers from each team will be asked to time. We will have two timers per lane. **Timers meeting is at 7:45 a.m. at the computer table.**
- Events:** 25, 50, 100-meter events (in each stroke) as well as the 100 IM, 200 IM, and 200 free, medley relays, mixed medley relays, free relays, mixed free relays, and mixed club free relays (just for fun!).
- All events are TIMED FINALS
 - Submit swimmer's best SHORT COURSE METER times for proper seeding
 - All events are open to all age groups & Masters 19+
 - Over the top starts may be done for all events that are 50+ (depends on number of swimmers entered)
 - No bull pen will be used.
 - **Heats will be mixed gender and pre-seeded by time (all ages swim together).**
 - **Meet will include medley and free mixed relays (2 boys and 2 girls).**
 - **Meet will include fun mixed club relays (please submit swimmer's best times in 25 or 50 free)**
 - **100 relays 10 & under and 200 relays 11 and over.**
 - **Individual results will be separated into age groups and gender.**
- Scoring:** Individual 9, 7, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1 and Relays 18, 14, 12, 10, 8, 6, 4, 2
- Results:** Will be posted on the wall behind the slide and on meet mobile.
- Awards:** Heat winners will be responsible for picking up their awards from the award table.
Ribbons: Individual 1st-8th, and Relays 1st-4th. High point medals will be awarded for 1st-3rd in each age group and gender, and 1st-3rd team trophies will be awarded.
- Entry Limit:** Each swimmer may swim a maximum of 5 individual events, 2 relays, and a mixed club relay.
- Entries:** All teams are encouraged to enter the meet with Hy-Tek. **Entries must be sent to Angie Schupp at perryvillepiranhas@gmail.com by 7:00 p.m. on Tuesday, September 24.** Please include a contact name and phone number. An e-mail that your entries were received will be sent to you. **Deck entries will only be accepted the day of the meet IF the swimmer is already registered for the meet, and IF there is an open lane. No new heats will be created.**
