	4. Each team is allowed three 30 second timeouts per half.
	5. Games going into overtime will consist of two minutes with 1 timeout per team. No timeouts carry over from the second half.
	6. A 28.5 basketball will be used as the game ball for teams 12 and under. 29 will be used for 13 and up.
	7. If teams have a tied record after pool play. The tiebreaker will be point differential for seeding. (Example points scored minus points allowed) If there is still a tie, we will use the number of points scored as a second tiebreaker.
