AAU Membership:

- This event is licensed by the AAU.
- All athletes and coaches must have a current 2022 AAU Membership before registering online. The athlete's fee is \$14 and the fee for coaches is \$16.
- **IMPORTANT: Please bring a copy of your AAU Membership to the pool.**
- AAU membership is not included as part of the entry fee to the event.
- AAU **Youth** Athlete membership must be obtained before the competition begins except where the event operator has a laptop available with an internet connection. **Be Prepared: Adult and Non Athlete memberships are no longer instant and cannot be applied for at an event. Please allow 10 days for membership to be processed.**
