We will be running 2 gyms as always.

Registration: This year, to limit entries, registration will be completed through Track Wrestling by Thursday February 8 at Midnight.

Weight of a wrestler will be checked if contested. They must be within 3% of registered weight.

AGE DIVISIONS: Tot, Bantam, Midget, Novice, Schoolboy & Cadet

RATING: 1. Finish 1, 2, 3 in previous AAU/USA State Meet

2. Finish 4, 5, 6 in previous AAU/USA State Meet or four or more years of experience

3. Three years of experience or less

4. First year wrestlers only

BRACKETING: Four-man round robin, wherever possible

FORMAT: MSHAA match rules with these exceptions:

1. Length - (1-1-1) – Bantam, Midget, Novice; (2-1-1) – Schoolboy, Cadet

2. Overtime – 1 min sudden victory, two 30 second periods (if still tied), 30 second final sudden victory

AWARDS: Plaque awarded for 1st place, medals awarded for 2nd and 3rd place

REFEREES: We will have certified AAU referees

ENTRY FEE: \$25.00 per wrestler – non-refundable. Payment will be made during registration via Track Wrestling.

ADMISSION: No Entry Fees

CONCESSIONS: Concession stand available during the entire tournament.

HOSPITALITY ROOM: We will have a hospitality room for referees, table workers & coaches with AAU cards

SCHOOL POLICY: No one is allowed to enter the gym with a cooler. No smoking is allowed on school premises!

AAU REQUIREMENTS:

- This event is licensed by the Amateur Athletic Union of the U.S., Inc.
- All participants must have a current AAU membership.
- AAU membership may not be included as part of the entry fee to the event.
- AAU Youth Athlete membership must be obtained before the competition begins, except where the event operator has a laptop available with an internet connection.
- Be Prepared: Adult and Non-Athlete memberships are no longer instant and cannot be applied for at an event.
- Due to background screenings, please allow up to 10 days for adult memberships to be processed.
- Participants are encouraged to visit the AAU website www.ausports.org to obtain their membership.
- ALL coaches must have a printed out AAU coach's card displayed in a lanyard around neck or showing on their

persons. No cards on a phone will be accepted to coach. (These are new AAU Ozark rules.)
