**Girls Division:** Girl division wrestlers must weigh-in at our tournament. Madison bracketing will be used and all age divisions in the Girls Division will be grouped by actual weight after weigh-ins close on Sunday.

**High School Division:** High school wrestlers must weigh-in and will be given a 3-pound weight allowance.

\*\*All wrestlers must weigh-in wearing whatever they are going to wrestle in.
