**PARKING FEE:** **\$5.00 per Vehicle, no Parking on the grass! Violators will be towed at the expense of the vehicle owner!**

**AGE DIVISIONS:** 8 & Under, 9U, 10U, 11U, 12U, 13U, 14U, 15-16U & 17-18U (Boys & Girls)

**EVENT LIMITATIONS:** This meet is open to any athlete that falls within the age divisions listed above. Athletes aged 13 and older may enter in up to a maximum of 4 events including relays. Younger age brackets may only enter in 3 events including relays. If an athlete is entered into too many events, meet management reserves the right to reject the athlete from one or more events without notification.

**SPECTATOR FEE:** **\$10.00 General Admission - Kids 5 & Under FREE**

**ENTRY PROCESS:** All teams and unattached athletes must register online at [www.coachoregistration.com](http://www.coachoregistration.com). This will permit a very efficient registration process that is easy to use.

**DEADLINE:** Teams and independent athletes will have until Wednesday, May 15, 2024 at 11:59 PM ET to complete registration. Please note that you must pay for your entries with a credit card online or your entries will not be accepted. Immediately after registering online, teams will receive a receipt from the Coach O website, which will produce a list of all athletes registered for the meet. This receipt should be used as your transcript of your meet entries. If your athletes do not appear on the confirmation, they are not registered for the meet. Please take care of these issues prior to arriving at the meet.

**PACKET PICK-UP:** Saturday May 18<sup>th</sup> at Estero High School 21900 River Ranch Road Estero, FL 33928  
**TIME: 6:45 AM – 2:00 AM**

**EVENT CHECK-IN:** All participants must check in at the Clerk of Course when their event is called. Field Event participants must report directly to the official in charge of the event when the event is called.

**FACILITY:** ALL – Weather 8 Lane Track and Runway – ¼ inch spikes or less. Fully Automatic Timing (F.A.T.) & results will be posted on-line only at [www.coacho.com](http://www.coacho.com). No smoking, radios, glass containers, or alcoholic beverages are allowed in the facility.

**COACHES BANDS:** \*1 free Band for 9 or less registered athletes.  
\*3 free Bands for 10-19 registered athletes.  
\*5 free Bands per 20 registered athletes (maximum 20 bands per team)

**BIB NUMBERS:** All competitors must wear their assigned bib numbers during competition and on the front on their jerseys only. If an athlete loses their bib number, a replacement can be purchased for a fee of \$10.00. Bib numbers will be distributed to athletes at the Timing Tent located at the Finish Line on the Track.

**PROTESTS:** There will be a \$50.00 fee for all protests. Protests must be submitted in writing to the Games Committee at once and must be submitted not later than 30 minutes after results have been posted/announced. The protest fee will be refunded if the protest is upheld.

**AWARDS:** 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, & 3<sup>rd</sup> Place Individual Medals.  
1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, & 3<sup>rd</sup> Place Team Trophies will be given to the teams that score the most points in each age group category above. Team trophies will be awarded after the final event on Saturday. Points will be awarded to the top 8 places using the following point scale 10-8-6-5-4-3-2-1.

**SECURITY:** Lee County Park and Recreation and TPBA Event Staff maintains the right to search any bags, backpacks, purses, jackets, etc. throughout the duration of the Florida Gulf Coast Relays.

**TENTS:** Pop-up Tents and Umbrella will be allowed at the top of the Bleachers (**except for the area directly in front of the Press Box**) and in the grass outside of the stadium. Please be respectful and allow everyone an opportunity to view the Meet. No tents are allowed on the grass surrounding the perimeter of the track. This includes the area near the scoreboard and along the gate near the Clerk's Tent.

**FOOD:** The Tony Perkins Basketball Academy maintains the exclusive rights to concessions. Outside food and beverage are not permitted.
