**ELIGIBILITY:** Competitors ages 6U-12 may enter a maximum of three events, including relays. Competitors ages 13+ may enter a max of four events, including relays. **\*\*Limit 4 Females and 4 Males per age group in the 400m dash**\*\*

**FIELD EVENTS**: 3 attempts only in the Shot Put, Discus, Long Jump, Turbo Javelin & High Jump. Athletes must check out with the official prior to leaving to compete in another event. Running events take precedence over field events.

**ENTRY INFO:** All entries will be done online by going to www.coacho.com. **Entries must be entered on Coach O by Wednesday, May 10th 11:59pm**. Mailed, faxed, emailed, phone entries and/or changes will not be accepted. All payments must be done online. NO REGISTRATION FOR EVENTS ON THE DAY OF THE EVENT AND NO CHANGES; NO EXCEPTIONS.

## \$15 per athlete; \$800 team max

**FACILITY:** 400 meter all weather track with 8 lanes 42"; all weather runways and concrete circles; FAT timing. No radios/speakers, glass containers, or open grills allowed in the Stadium. **Tents and/or umbrellas will be allowed on the top row of the stadium only <u>excluding in front of the press box</u>. Restrooms are available at the facility. Parking lots are located near the Stadium. Concession will be open during the meet. Trash cans will be available and <b>teams should police their own areas for trash**.

**MEET RULES & REGULATIONS:** No bare feet or stocking feet; shirts required; max 1/4" spikes; Athletes on all relay teams must be dressed in the same uniform; Maximum of two relays per age group. Only the designated "A" team will be able to earn points and be counted toward team awards/scoring. Call to check-in will be made as follows: 1st Call, FINAL CALL. Co-ed Relays will be run with the boys age group.

**EQUIPMENT:** Throwers must use their own implements, and will be subject to inspection. Starting blocks will be used for the 100m Finals Only.

### NOTES:

- 1. We will use a rolling schedule.
- 2. All running events are final with the exception of the 100m. The 100m dash will be a 1 heat final. Top 8 will advance.
- 3. Order for running events Youngest to oldest age groups
- 4. Girls run first in each age group
- 5. Please check in on first call
