ATHLETES WILL ONLY BE ELIGIBLE TO COMPETE IN THE EVENT(S) THEY REGISTERED FOR PRIOR TO THE CLOSE OF REGISTRATION. NO CHANGES WILL BE MADE ON THE DAY OF COMPETITION.

The fee per athlete is \$25.00 (Please note that the fee is the same as 2022)

- All entries and fees must be received by no later than May 31, 2024.
- 2. Maximum number of events per athlete: 12&U = 3 Events including relay; 13-14 Events = 4 including relay; Multi-Events do not count as one of your events and are not competed at the District Qualifier. Individuals wishing to compete in a multi-event may register directly at the Regional level.
- 3. All entry fees must be paid by credit card online via CoachO www.coacho.com

<u>AAU MEMBERSHIP</u>: All athletes and coaches must be current members of the AAU in order to participate in the meet and must be able to present their AAU card upon request at the time of check-in. All memberships must be obtained on-line at <u>www.aausports.org</u>.

<u>AWARDS</u>: Awards will be available for pick-up approximately 30 minutes after event results are announced and posted. AAU Championship medals will be awarded to 1st – 3rd place finishers and ribbons for 4th–6th place finishers in each event.

<u>ADVANCEMENT</u>: The District Qualifier is an advancement meet. The top sixteen (16) finishers in each individual event and relay shall advance from the District Qualifier to the Regional Qualifier. For all events contested at the District level, competitors are only eligible to advance from the District level to the Regional Championship in the events that they actually compete <u>and</u> finish in the top 16. All running events will be contested as a timed-final.

<u>PACKET PICK-UP:</u> Packets will be available for pick-up: Friday, June 7, Dr. Henry A. Wise High School 6:30pm – 7:30pm Saturday, June 8, Dr. Henry A. Wise High School 6:45am

TENT SET-UP: Friday, June 7 at 7-8:00pm. ANY SPACE RESERVED BEFORE THAT TIME WILL BE REMOVED. No tents may be set up in front of the press box. THE FIRST BLEACHER SECTION AT THE FINISH LINE IS RESERVED FOR THE HOST TEAM, MARLBORO BOYS & GIRLS CLUB TRACK.

<u>ADMISSION:</u> PAYMENT MAY BE MADE BY CASH OR \$CASH APP. SATURDAY ONLY ADMISSION: \$5.00 PER PERSON (ALL AGES). One (1) coaches' pass will be issued for every ten (10) registered athletes.

PROTEST PROCEDURES: The meet director must be notified in writing within 30 minutes of the perceived infraction. A seventy-five (\$75.00) dollar cash **non-refundable** fee is required at the time of the protest. The decision of the jury of appeals is final.

FACILITIES: Eight lane track, runways, and aprons require ½ " spikes or less. Pyramid spikes are not permitted.

CLEAN-UP: PLEASE POLICE YOUR ATHLETES AND YOUR AREA. TRASH BAGS WILL BE AVAILABLE FOR YOUR USE. Coaches who fail to ensure that their respective team areas are appropriately maintained and cleaned may be precluded from further participation in the meet.

EQUIPMENT: Each team/athlete must supply their own field event implements, starting blocks, and batons. However, it may be necessary to select a field implement as the Official Implement to be used by all of the competitors. Blocks are only permitted in the 100m and must be provided by the competitor.

<u>ADDITIONAL NOTES (General)</u>: Sections, heats, flights WILL be combined at the discretion of the meet director or field event judges.

ONLY MEET OFFICIALS ARE ALLOWED ON THE FIELD, TRACK OR IN THE CLERKING AREA. ONLY ATHLETES WHOSE EVENT HAS BEEN CALLED ARE ALLOWED ON THE TRACK, FIELD OR IN THE CLERKING AREA. ATHLETES MUST REPORT TO THE CLERKING AREA DRESSED FOR COMPETITION.
