The entry fee covers all of the above listed events. Competitors may compete in any or all events.

Rules:

All sparring divisions will be using AAU Karate Sanban Rules. Empty Hand and weapons Katas may be from any system of Karate or Kobudo

COVID policy:

Venue: The venue will be an **outdoor** pavilion and you are encouraged to bring your own lawn chair for viewing from a distance in designated socially distanced spots.

Kata/Weapons: Katas will be performed individually to allow for generous social distancing.

Kumite: A mask and/or <u>solid</u> faceshield will be required, athletes will sanitize their hands and feet at the start of each match. Face contact will not be tolerated.

Games: Each dojo parents support group is encouraged to set up a booth or 2 of some silly game that can be played in a safe way (think Trunk or Treat). Lets let those creative juices flow and have some fun! Each game will need to be approved prior to the event.

Weather Policy:

If soccer can compete outside at this time of year then so can we! If it rains on the day of competition, we will continue the competition as we will be under cover. If there is lightening the competition will be delayed until the storm passes. We will continue the event into the following day if it storms all day. The remainder of the competition will be canceled and all unused entries refunded if both days have extended storms.
