\*\*We will not have team fees and no team awards. We are anticipating that we will not be able to have all of one level in a session due number of gymnasts per session limitations. We will send all team placements at the conclusion. Clubs may create their own banners/awards as they see fit. \*No awards will be given for team competition.

**All coaches on the competition floor must be registered AAU Non-Athlete Members AND MUST ALSO REGISTER on Insight.scoreflippers.com Gymnasts and coaches must have their AAU membership prior to registering. Registration cannot be completed without a 2020-2021 AAU Membership.**
- \*AAU membership may not be included as part of the meet entry fee.  
\*A convenience fee will be incurred when payment is made by credit/debit card at the uses fee (if you use a bank account no fee) \*\* The per gymnast INSIGHT user fee is included as part of per gymnast entry fee.
- Refunds:** No refunds unless canceled for pandemic reasons. If canceled for pandemic reasons refunds will be sent minus expenses already incurred such as administrative (example: INSIGHT/ License fee, any items already purchased).

- AAU Levels:** High School Rules, Level 1 – Open Optional, & Ladies & All Xcel (Bronze, Silver, Gold, Platinum, Diamond) (High School National Rules will be used and gymnasts may be any age per AAU guidelines. The HS sessions will be judged by Certified HS ranked judges). (\*\*WI is a pilot for the High School rules and will not be available at Regionals or Nationals. If a gymnast competes in the HS session they can register for nationals in a suitable/comparable level\*\*).
- Age Groups:** Age Divisions will be determined by # of entries in each level. Gymnasts must be 4 years of age by the date of competition.
- Rules:** AAU National Rules – No District Modifications.  
National High School Federation Rules – No District Modifications.

\*Individual event awards are awarded to the top 50% + 1 within each age division.  
\*All District State Award – Given to the highest All-Around score per level.  
\*All gymnasts and coaches will receive a great AAU State Gift.

**ALL GYMNASTS & COACHES ON COMPETITIVE FLOOR MUST BE AAU REGISTERED** This event is licensed by the Amateur Athletic Union of the U.S., Inc. All participants must have a current AAU membership. AAU membership may not be included as part of the entry fee to the event. AAU Youth Athlete membership must be obtained before the competition begins. **BE PREPARED!** Adult and Non-Athlete memberships are no longer instant and cannot be applied for at event. Please allow at least 10 days for membership to be processed. Participants are encouraged to visit the AAU website: [www.aausports.org](http://www.aausports.org) to obtain their membership.

**Judging Rules:** This is not a USAG meet. AAU only follows USAG routine rules for guidelines. AAU follows USAG routines **with some changes**. Please see the AAU website for handbook rules at [www.aausports.org](http://www.aausports.org). Go to publications for the gymnastics handbook. Please see that some routines are different than that of USAG. Wisconsin Does NOT change any routines from the AAU National rules allowed. We will use the National High School Federation Rules with no modifications. (No MAGA rules/modifications).

**Advancing to Regionals & Nationals =** The WI District Championships will qualify gymnasts to the AAU Regionals & Nationals. AAU Midwest Regionals TBA - AAU Nationals June 23<sup>rd</sup> – 27<sup>th</sup> 2021 in Savannah, Georgia (Yes, changed from Orlando; just updated Jan. 23rd.)

Registration BEGINS February 1<sup>st</sup>, 2021 and will remain open for regular fee until Saturday March 6th, 2021 at midnight. Late registration will be open from March 7<sup>th</sup>, 2021 and remain open until Saturday April 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2021 at midnight.

Some great things to know about this MEET GENIE:

Scoreflippers was the company that we had at the AAU 2019 WI State & Regional Championships. If you attended either of these meets your Club will already be listed. If your gymnasts attended either of these meets they will already be listed also. You will just need to update their level/ and enter their new AAU Membership number. If you register them and do not change their level at time of registration you will be charged to change their level if you need change it at a later date. (\*\*Always double check the spelling and birthdate of your athletes \*\*).

\*\*You can also upload an INDIVIDUAL PHOTO of each gymnast to their registration. (This can also be done at a later time; this does not have to be done when registering). This photo will appear with their name on the scoring display monitor! And remember they will always have their scores in the system for any meets using the Scoreflippers scoring system!

\*\*Please list your Club as you wish to have it presented/announced in the program, march in signs, meet memorabilia, shirts, awards, etc. No abbreviations or shorthand. Thank you!

**\*\*Meet Protocol\*\*** We will be following the guidelines of the CDC and LaCrosse County Health authorities and the most up to date measures will be taken for a safe environment for all who attend.

\*No Spectator limit due to the size of the facility and the smaller sessions we will be holding.
