Modified Pentathlon – Boys and Girls 11u to 14u (1:00 PM Start)

Shotput, High Jump, Long Jump)

Modified Triathlon – Boys and Girls 9u to 10u (1:00 PM Start) (High Jump, Shotput)

AAU GULF DISTRICT 2021 MEET GUIDELINES

Required COVID-19 guidelines to implement for 2021 Track & Field Season:

Mask & Face Covering Requirements

i. All Athletes, Coaches, and spectators must wear masks upon arrival to the facility.

ii. All spectators and athletes in attendance MUST wear masks during the course

of the event when physical distancing of 6 feet or more is not possible

iii. ALL meet Administrators, Officials, and Meet management staff must wear face coverings at all times during the management of the meet when Social Distancing is not possible.

iv. If health conditions prevent anyone from wearing a mask, they should be encouraged to remain in the parking lot and away from the event. This will help protect the safety and well-being of all others in attendance

ALL AMERICAN THROWERS FIELD EVENT CHAMPIONSHIP

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Athlete Events	Athletes are allowed 3 Events and one Combined Event. We are trying to produce a quality meet for all involved. We must exit the stadium by 4 PM. We will strive to provide the best quality meet possible within the timeframe. Athletes must register and pay through <u>www.CoachO.com</u> .
Parking	Park on the Home side (closest to West Nasa Road) on the South Side by the Field Events Area. The Stadium Gates to the Stands will not be open.
Officials	All American Throwers will be providing Certified Officials for the Meet. We want a championship format for the athletes.
Competition Area	Only Athletes, Officials, Volunteers, and a limited number of Coaches will be allowed inside the fenced in area for the Competition. We ask that spectators stay outside the fenced in area and Social Distance. We will set up an Athlete Water Point under tents between the Javelin Runway and Pole Vault. Also, a second Athlete Water Point will be set up round High Jump.
Food Trucks	Based on Gulf AAU guidelines, we will utilize food trucks to provide food, drinks, and snacks at the meet.
Live Results	AthleticLive.net will have live results posted during the meet. You can Download that APP at the Apple Store or Google Play.
Awards	Medals will be provided for 1 st to 6 th Place. The medals will be handed out at the event.
Team Award	The Team Award will be based on total points. The Team Award is a Trophy and a \$500 Gift Card to Track Barn for Team Equipment. The Host Team is not eligible to participate.
Protests	All protests will cost \$50.00 Cash. The protest needs to be submitted within 30 minutes of the end of the event. All protests will go before the Head Field Referee for decisions. Protests made need to show the USATF Rule and Violation.
Sponsors	We will acknowledge all the sponsors throughout the meet. We encourage all participants to thank any of the sponsors they may see. We want to encourage the sponsors to help provide another great venue for a future Field Event Championship.
