**Eligibility:** Open to all AAU registered swimmers. Swimmers age on July 25, 2019 will determine the age for the meet (the first day of competition at the Junior Olympics)

**Swimmers who have qualified at other meets will swim exhibition only. 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> place medals will be awarded to exhibition swimmers. Please be sure to mark exhibition when appropriate.**

**Entries:** A Team Manager event file will be available at: <http://smcswim.com/index/html> Swimmers may compete in five individual events. The number of swimmers is limited to 200. Please submit times in long course meter and email entries in Team Manger file format to Beth Lewis [xcbeth@yahoo.com](mailto:xcbeth@yahoo.com). Also, please bring a flash drive and entries with you the day of the meet. It is extremely important to get entries done on time.

**\*\*\*Heat Awards\*\*\*** Heat ribbons will be given to all heat winners

**\*\*\*Awards must be picked up by the coach or team representative. Due to the expense of the medals, MEDALS WILL BE ORDERED AFTER THE COMPLETION OF THE MEET. They will be handed to the Teams' coaches at a later date**

Swimmers must check in with the clerk 30 minutes prior to the start of the meet. It is the swimmer's responsibility to report promptly to the bullpen when their event is called.

- AAU membership may not be included as part of the entry fee to the event.
- AAU Youth Athlete membership must be obtained before the competition begins except where the event operator has a laptop available with an internet connection. **Be Prepared:** Adult and Non Athlete memberships are no longer instant and cannot be applied for at event. Please allow 10 days for membership to be processed.
