The top sixteen (16) finishers, in each individual and/or relay event shall advance, in those event, from the District Qualifier, to the Regional 6 National Qualifier Meet.

The following events will be passed through to the Regional 6 National Qualifier Meet: Steeplechase, Pole Vault, and Javelin.

Packet pickup for Teams and Unattached Athletes will start at 7:00am

Athletes must bring their own implements for Turbo Javelin, Shot Put, and Discus. Teams must supply their own starting blocks and batons for relays.

Coaches must have a wristband on wrist and a copy of your AAU Coaching Card to enter stadium.

Athletes must have wrist band ON to enter stadium also athletes must have on a bib number and wristband to enter check-in at clerk of course.

Caution: Coaches and Parents please keep all of your kids and athletes from playing under the bleaches and ETC.

Please, keep all your Trash and Paper picked up in your area, Please. Extra Trash Bags will be provided in press box.

No taunting of Coaches, Officials or Athletes, Please respect everyone.

No standing at fence doing lane races. Stand back 2 feet from fence doing those events.

No one but Meet Officials' and Athletes are to be in Clerk of Course Area and on inner field.

Don't block walkways with tents or chairs.

In the event the meet is delayed due to lightning, the Meet Director will make an updated announcement every 20 minutes until the meet is resumed.

Tents, Small and Large (Patio) Umbrellas' in stands on **top 5 rows only** and not in front of Press Box at all.

Anyone seen without the right wristband on wrist, will be asked to leave track meet immediately.

There will be an admission charge for all spectators ages 7 and up.
