Coaches who have not completed the AAU Coaches Certification by the day of competition will not receive a coaches pass.

## For Coaches and Competitors

### Both Athletes and Coaches MUST be current 2023 AAU members

### **AAU Membership:**

**Youth & Adult Athlete Membership:** All competitors, youth and adult, must have a current 2023 AAU Membership. Youth membership is \$14.00 and Adult membership is \$24. Both Athlete memberships are available immediately.

**Youth & Adult Non-Athlete Membership:** All coaches and officials must have a current 2023 AAU Membership. Adult membership is \$16. Additionally, as part of AAU's commitment to youth safety, all adults who request membership will have a background check. Please allow for at least 10 working days for the membership to be completed.

### **Coaches Certification:**

The AAU Taekwondo Online Coaches Certification is required annually in order to coach at any sanctioned AAU Taekwondo event, including this District Championship. This certification is for the current competition year only so the coach must have completed after September 1, 2022.

Certification/Recertification is required each year. There are different courses you may select to be certified as a coach. You must have a certification for the qualifying events in order to coach for them. Make sure you take the appropriate test. Anyone who will be 14 any time during 2023 may take this course and upon passing will be allowed to coach at any AAU Taekwondo event.

Go to <u>AAU - Taekwondo (aautaekwondo.org) - Coaches Certification</u> to complete the appropriate course. The tournament director will only provide coaches passes to those who are reflected on the AAU website as having completed the coach's certification or that can provide their 2023 Certification card at check-in.

All athletes and coaches must register on-line for the tournament prior to the LATE registration deadline of March 16, 2023. Anyone not registered by this deadline will be unable to compete or coach in the tournament.



## Point Sparring Competition Rules

Please read the full rules and policies as outlined in the AAU Taekwondo Handbook.

### **Divisions:**

Competition at this event shall be divided by Height (in), and Gender. Depending upon the number of athletes, the tournament director may combine divisions by age and belt, where appropriate. When height is used to divide competitors within a division, a divisional grand champion round will be run between the shorter and taller division winners in each division. National's qualification will be determined based on the finishes in the initial tall and short divisions.

#### Match Times:

There will be one round per preliminary match. All preliminary matches will be two minutes running time or a 10-point gap, whichever occurs first. If the match runs the full two minutes, the competitor ahead on score will be declared the winner. If a match is tied at the end of the two minutes, a Golden Round will determine the match. A competitor must win the Golden Round by a two (2) point net change in the score.

All Divisional Grand Championship matches will be one (1) two-minute round but a competitor must win by two points.

#### Points:

One point will be awarded for any valid hand technique executed to the legal body or head area. One point will be awarded for any valid foot technique executed to the legal body area. Two points will be awarded for any valid foot technique executed to the legal head area. Three points will be awarded for any valid spinning foot technique executed to the legal head area.

All contact must be made with light contact.



# Southeastern AAU Taekwondo District Championship & National Qualifier March 18, 2023 Para Taekwondo Competition

Para Taekwondo Competition (formerly known as Special Needs Competition) has three types of competition, Forms/Patterns, Point Sparring and Olympic Sparring (new). Each competition follows the rules for Forms/Patterns, Point Sparring and Olympic Sparring, respectively, with the specific modifications. Please refer to the 2023 AAU Taekwondo Handbook for these rules.

For this competition, if there is no one in an athlete's division, the tournament director may combine divisions, where modifications are the same. Also, in sparring competition, if there is no one in their division, the tournament director may allow for a coach to provide competition for the athlete in the sparring division.

Board Breaking and Weapons Forms will have no modifications to existing rules. Para Taekwondo Competitors will compete in divisions determined by age and belt rank.



### Board Breaking Guidelines Non-Qualifying Event

Breaking will be bracketed and timed.

Board Breaking Rules- Boards must be purchased from our National Sponsor AAMA by visiting website <a href="www.aamasupply.com">www.aamasupply.com</a>. There will be also be boards available at the event site. They will be sold in packs of 10 boards.

All Board Holders must be an AAU member AND be either a registered athlete or coach for this event in order to hold boards for this event. A maximum of 2 board holders and 2 board feeders will be allowed. If cinder blocks are used, a maximum of 2 feeders will be allowed.

Board Breaking: Repetitive Spin Hook - Allowed technique is spinning hook kick

- Single break format; One board per strike
- 10 board competition
- Winner based on lowest time required to break 10 boards

Board Breaking: Repetitive Side Kick - Allowed technique is side kick

- Single break format; One board per strike
- 10 board competition
- Winner based on lowest time required to break 10 board

### **Board Breaking: Repetitive Hand Technique**

- Single break format; One board per strike
- Allowed technique is hammer fist, palm, knife or fist (punch)
- 10 board competition
- Winner based on lowest time required to break 10 boards

### **BOARD SIZES:**

All athletes will use AAMA Demo Size Medium boards.

Coaches must be prepared to hold boards for their athletes. Other athletes may be allowed to hold boards for athletes, but they must be registered for the tournament AND have their dobok on while holding. Blocks will be available for repetitive hand breaking. Coaches must have a coaches pass to be on the floor to hold boards.

### **Weapons Forms: Traditional**

- Brazilian Repechage Format
- No live blades will be allowed
- Minimum one hand must remain in contact with the weapon at all times
- Inverted aerial maneuvers are not allowed, rolls are allowed, cartwheels are not allowed
- 90 second time limit
- Judging criteria includes Technique, Power, Focus, Rhythm, Grace and Beauty
- Only one weapon may be used

### **Weapons Forms: Creative**

- Brazilian Repechage Format
- No live blades will be allowed
- Weapon releases are allowed in creative division
- Inverted aerial maneuvers are allowed in creative division
- 90 second time limit
- Judging criteria includes Creativity, Technique, Power, Focus, Rhythm, Grace and Beauty

### Directions to Venue



Smyrna High School is located southeast of Nashville, TN.

Located off Interstate 24, it is easily accessible from any direction. There will be plenty of visitor parking and seating available all day.

### **Directions:**

From Atlanta/Chattanooga/Southeast: Take I24W to Exit 70 north of Murfreesboro, TN. Take the ramp for TN-102 toward Smyrna and turn right onto Almaville Rd / TN-102. Go 2.2 miles and turn left onto Bulldog Drive.

From Knoxville/Lebanon/East: Take I40W to I840W towards Chattanooga/Memphis. At Exit 57, head right on the ramp toward Sulphur Springs Rd and turn right onto Sulphur Springs Rd. Go 1.8 miles and stay straight onto Florence Rd. Continue straight 0.1 miles onto George Franklin Rd. Proceed 0.6 miles and turn right onto US-70S/US-41N/TN-1/New Nashville Hwy. Proceed for 1.8 miles and take the ramp on the right and follow signs for I-24/TN-102. Merge onto TN-102. Turn right onto Bulldog Dr.

From Memphis/Arkansas: Take I40W to I840E towards Chattanooga/Knoxville. Take I24W towards Nashville to Exit 70 north of Murfreesboro, TN. Take the ramp for TN-102 toward Smyrna and turn right onto Almaville Rd / TN-102. Go 2.2 miles and turn left onto Bulldog Drive.

From St Louis/Louisville: Proceed to Nashville TN and take I24E out of Nashville to Exit 70 north of Murfreesboro, TN. Take the ramp for TN-102 toward Smyrna and turn right onto Almaville Rd / TN-102. Go 2.2 miles and turn left onto Bulldog Drive.
