RULES: Event Payments: Must be made online 3 weeks prior to the event. If you do not pay, you will not be put on the schedule. Events sell out fast, limited space. You can register to hold a spot but is only secured upon payment.

Game Guarantee: 4 games, 2-3 Saturday & 1-2 Sunday

Divisions: Boys and Girls, Silver and Gold in each age division. Silver teams should be same school/small school or 2nd/3rd tier select teams or big schools. Gold teams should be highly competitive teams, same school/big school or select teams. We reserve the right to adjust a teams' division.

Gate Fees: \$5/day per adult or \$20/weekend for a family pass (Aunt, Uncle, Grandma, Grandpa etc.)

Quarters: 7 minutes quarters for all age divisions. 3 minute half times.

Game Times: Game will start as early as 9:00am on Saturday and conclude by 9pm. Sunday will start as early as 9:00am and length of day depends on amount of teams. Gyms will open 30 minutes prior to the first game.

Basketballs: Teams provide their own basketball. 3rd grade (27.5) 4th - 6th grade boys & girls (28.5) 7th & 8th grade girls (28.5) 7th and 8th grade boys (29.5)

Uniforms: Home team is listed on top and will wear white/light. Away team is listed on bottom and will wear color/dark.

ADDITIONAL INFO: All games will be played at the SURC (Student Union & Recreation Center) located on the Central Washington University campus. The SURC hosts 4 courts in one location and on site food options. This event is a 4 game guarantee. Top Tier basketball events are designed to maximize development and competition for all teams and players. Our primary goal every weekend is to host a silver and gold division within each age division. If we do our job, teams do not win or lose by 40 points! We believe development and growth happens when players are put in highly competitive situations against similar skilled opponents and like minded teams.
