**AAU Membership:** License #**9KOZTW1866**. This is an AAU licensed tournament. AAU membership is **required** for all competitors, coaches, and officials prior to the event. Cost of membership: Coach only = \$16, Youth Athlete = \$14, Adult Athlete (18 & older) = \$24. Your membership number will be required during online registration. **Athlete Fees:** 1 Individual event - \$45 **\$10 for each additional event entered (see below for early reg. discounts)**  
Team forms (Black Belt only) \$30 per team (contact Pat at 314-620-1987 to register for this event)

**Coach and Spectator Fees:** **There is no fee for spectators. There is no fee for coaches who have taken the clinic and registered online prior to the event. There will be a \$15 fee charged for coaches who do have not taken the clinic and pre-registered online prior to the registration deadline..**

**Athlete Registration Deadline:** **Registration deadline is May 5. There will be a \$10 early registration discount for entries made by 4/7. Regular entry fees apply to entries made from 4/8 – 5/5. A \$15 late fee will apply to entries made 5/6 - 5/8. Absolutely no registrations will be accepted after May 8.**

**Awards:** AAU Association Championship medals will be awarded for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> places for all events. AAU ribbons will be awarded for 5<sup>th</sup> thru 8<sup>th</sup> competitors.

**Equipment:** Equipment requirements will follow AAU rules with the exception of gear color. Foam swords will be provided for foam sword sparring, as will face shields for those competitors needing them.
