FINAL MEET SCHEDULE WILL BE PUBLISHED AT CLOSE OF REGISTRATION

In order to host the District Qualifier amid challenges and limitations resulting from the COVID-19 pandemic, and accommodate the High School Track and Field competition season, the format for this year's meet is being modified. Please pay strict attention to the event calendar and schedule of events.

Note: With limited exception, participation in a District Qualifier is a requirement for advancement to the Regional Championship.

EXCEPTIONS:

1. **FOR AGES 15-18 ONLY:** Events will not be contested at the Potomac Valley District Qualifier for the 15-18 Age Groups. These athletes have the option of: (1) requesting a [waiver](#)/automatic advancement to Regional Championship **IF** they are unavailable May 27th – May 28th **due to competition in a high school meet.** Proof of participation will be required by AAU; (2) competing in a neighboring District Qualifier.

Relay Teams in the 15-18 Age Group will be eligible for [waiver](#)/automatic advancement to Regional Championship IF one or more of the relay team members is eligible for waiver based upon Exception (1) above. All other relay teams must exercise exception (2) above to qualify for the Regional Qualifier.

The meet host is NOT involved in the [waiver](#) process and does not have the authority to grant waivers. Waivers must be requested directly from AAU Track and Field (Coach O).

2. **ADVANCED EVENTS:** Athletes participating in the following events will be advanced to the next level. These events will not be competed at the District level and will be open registration events at the AAU PVA Region 3 Qualifier registration on coacho.com.

DEADLINE FOR ENTRIES AND FEES:

1. The fee per athlete is \$25.00 (Please note that the fee is the same as 2019)
2. All entries and fees must be received by no later than May 20, 2022.
3. Maximum number of events per athlete – 12&U = 3 Events including relay; 13-14 Events = 4 including relay; Multi-Events do not count as one of your events.
4. All entry fees must be paid by credit card online via CoachO www.coacho.com

AAU MEMBERSHIP: All athletes and coaches must be current members of the AAU in order to participate in the meet and must be able to present their AAU card upon request at the time of check-in. All memberships must be obtained on-line at www.aausports.org.

AWARDS: Awards will be available for pick-up approximately 30 minutes after event results are announced and posted. AAU Championship medals will be awarded to 1st – 3rd place finishers and ribbons for 4th–6th place finishers in each event.

ADVANCEMENT: The District Qualifier is an advancement meet. The top sixteen (16) finishers in each individual event and relay shall advance from the District Qualifier to the Regional Qualifier. **For all events contested at the District level**, competitors are only eligible to advance from the District level to the Regional Championship in the events that they actually compete and finish in the top 16.

TENT SET-UP: Friday May 27th 5:00pm; Saturday May 28th 7:00am; Tuesday May 31st 5:00pm. Any space reserved before that time will be removed. **No tents may be set up in front of the press boxes at either site. The first belcher section at the finish line is reserved for the host team, Marlboro Boys & Girls Club Track.**

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ADMISSION: Daily admission for spectators will be charged: \$5 ages (5 – 64); under 5 and 65 and older (w/ID) – free. One (1) coaches' pass will be issued for every ten (10) registered athletes.

PROTEST PROCEDURES: The meet director must be notified in writing within 30 minutes of the perceived infraction. A seventy-five (\$75.00) dollar cash **non-refundable** fee is required at the time of the protest. The decision of the jury of appeals is final.

FACILITIES: Eight lane track, runways, and aprons require ¼ " spikes or less. Pyramid spikes are not permitted.

CLEAN-UP: Trash bags will be provided. Please keep your area clean. Coaches who fail to ensure that their respective team areas are appropriately maintained and cleaned may be precluded for further participation in the meet.

EQUIPMENT: Each team/athlete must supply their own field event implements, starting blocks, and batons. However, it may be necessary to select a field implement as the Official Implement to be used by all of the competitors. Blocks are only permitted in the finals of the 100m and must be provided by the competitor.

ADDITIONAL NOTES (General): Sections, heats, flights may be combined at the discretion of the meet director or field event judges.

ONLY MEET OFFICIALS ARE ALLOWED ON THE FIELD, TRACK OR IN THE CLERKING AREA. ONLY ATHLETES WHOSE EVENT HAVE BEEN CALLED ARE ALLOWED ON THE TRACK, FIELD OR IN THE CLERKING AREA. ATHLETES MUST REPORT TO THE CLERKING AREA DRESSED FOR COMPETITION.

ALL ATHLETES MUST PARTICIPATE IN THEIR AGE GROUP FOR **ALL** EVENTS.
