**Saturday Schedule: (Rolling schedule)**

7:00am – Doors Open  
8:00am – 6U Girls, 6U Boys, 10U Boys, 12U Girls, 12U Boys will wrestle through 4th round wrestle backs. Placing matches to be wrestled on Sunday.  
1:00pm (approx.) – 8U Girls, 8U Boys, 10U Girls, 14 Girls, 14U Boys will begin wrestling immediately following SDWCA Awards and the conclusion of the first five divisions listed above and will wrestle through the 4th round of wrestlebacks. Placing matches to be wrestled on Sunday.  
***Any weight classes of (5) or fewer will finish on Saturday***

7:00am – Doors Open  
8:00am – Lineup for Parade of Athletes  
8:15am – Parade of Athletes place winners and state qualifiers wishing to participate. Wrestlers will line up and enter by town/club. Clubs are encouraged to bring team banners.  
Immediately following Parade of Athletes – Placing matches start with 6U division until completion
