**ELIGIBILITY:** This meet is open to any athlete that falls within the age divisions listed below. AAU individual and club

memberships can be obtained through the AAU National Website <a href="www.aausports.org">www.aausports.org</a>. Each athlete aged <a href="mailto:13-18">13-18 years</a> may enter in up to a <a href="mailto:maximum of 4">maximum of 4 events including relays</a>. Athletes aged <a href="mailto:12">12 and younger</a> based on year of birth below may only enter in <a href="mailto:3">3 events including relays</a>. If an athlete is entered into too many events, meet management reserves the right to reject the athlete from one or more events without

notification.

**AGE DIVISIONS:** Age divisions are determined by year of birth. Listed below are the AAU Age Divisions.

5 & 6 Under Girls/Boys (Born 2017 and later) Maximum 3 Events including relays

7 & 8 Girls/Boys (Born 2015-2016 Maximum 3 Events including relays

9 & 10 Year Old Girls/Boys (Born 2013-2014) Maximum 3 Events including relays 11 & 12 Year Old Girls/Boys (Born 2011-2012) Maximum 3 Events including relays 13 & 14 Year Old Girls/Boys (Born 2009-2010) Maximum 4 Events including relays 15-16 Year Old Girls/Boys (Born 2007-2008) Maximum 4 Events including relays 17-18 Year Old Girls/Boys (Born 2005-2006) Maximum 4 Events including relays

\*Athletes who are still eighteen (18) years of age through the final day (August 5<sup>th</sup>) of the AAU Junior Olympics Games in Des Moines Iowa shall be eligible to compete in the 17–18-year-old division.

MEET ENTRY FEE: Entry fee is \$20.00 for each athlete for Track & Field events. All members of relay teams, including

alternates, who have not entered an individual event, must pay a \$20.00 entry fee. ALL FEES ARE NON-REFUNDABLE AND NON-TRANSFERABLE. ALL ENTRY FEES MUST BE PAID ONLINE. Entry will not be processed unless entry fee is paid by the deadline. All major credit cards accepted online.

Bring an original birth certificate, passport or driver's license as proof of age.

**ENTRY PROCESS:** All teams and unattached athletes must utilize the online entry process via <a href="www.coacho.org">www.coacho.org</a>. This will

permit a very efficient registration process that is easy to use. Everyone will have until 11:59pm CST, Wednesday, June 14, 2023 to complete registration. Immediately after registering online, you will receive a receipt from the website, which will produce a list of all athletes registered for the meet. This receipt should be used as your transcript of your meet entries. If your athletes do not appear on the confirmation,

they are not registered for the meet. Please take care of these issues prior to arriving to the meet, if at all possible. Absolutely no entries will be accepted after June 8, 2022.

PACKET PICKUP: SATURDAY, JUNE 17, 2023, 8:00AM - 4:00PM - PACKETS WILL BE AVAILABLE AT THE

**TRACK** (Renaissance HS). A packet will be provided for each team consisting of team roster and events

entered. A team representative will be responsible for picking up the packets.

**AWARDS:** In individual and relay events, awards will be presented for participants who finish  $1^{st} - 3^{rd}$  place.

A TEAM Trophy will be awarded to the TOP TEAM OVERALL.

Awards will be given to the TOP FEMALE and MALE ATHLETE of the meet

TRACK & FIELD LEGENDS AWARD - Honoring Track & Field Legends within Michigan

Special Recognition will be given to Michigan Track & Field Athletes that have gone off to the college.

**ADMISSION:** There will be a \$5.00 gate fee charge per person. All coaches will receive one free pass for 4 athletes,

two free passes for 5 to 15 athletes and 3 free passes for 16 or more athletes in their packet. Only one coaches pass for an unattached athlete can be purchased for \$5.00 at the time of packet pickup. All Children 5 and under will be admitted free. If the coaches band is lost or damaged a replacement wrist

band can be purchased for \$5.00.

**REFRESHMENTS:** A Partial Service Concession Stand will be provided as well as a hospitality area for officials.

**RESULTS:** Results will be posted online at <u>www.coacho.com</u>.

**COMPETITOR** Competitor bib numbers will be issued at packet pick-up. All athletes will be required to wear their

BIB NUMBERS: bib numbers on the front of your competition singlet at all times of competition. There is a ten-dollar

(\$10.00) replacement fee for lost bib numbers. Replacement bib numbers can be purchased at the pack

pickup area.

**IMPLEMENTS:** Athletes may bring their own implements to use during competition.

**PROTESTS:** Protests concerning the status or eligibility of any competitor must be made to the AAU Age Verification

Committee prior to the commencement of the meet, or the Referee during the meet. Protests relating to matters, which develop during the conduct of the meet, must be made to the Referee and be filed at once, but in any case not more than 30 minutes after the results has been announced. Protests MUST be filed in writing and presented to the Meet Director accompanied by a cash deposit of \$100.00. The Referee shall consider all available official evidence. When the Referee renders his/her decision, there is still the right of appeal to the Jury of Appeals. The jury's decision is final. If the protest is denied, the cash deposit

will be forfeited. PROTESTS CONCERNING JUDGMENT CALLS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.

- This event is licensed by the Amateur Athletic Union of the U.S., Inc.
- All participants must have a current AAU membership.
- AAU membership may not be included as part of the entry fee to the event.
- AAU **Youth** Athlete membership must be obtained before the competition begins, except where the event operator has a laptop available with an internet connection.

Be Prepared: Adult and Non-Athlete memberships are no longer instant and cannot be applied for at an event. Due to background screenings, please allow up to 10 days for adult memberships to be processed.

#### Field Event Schedule

Any athlete who does not check-in before their designated flight starts will be scratched from the event. Field Event athletes who have a conflict with a running event will be released by the **Field Event official – ONLY** - at the appropriate time. Field Event athletes will have 10 minutes to report back to their Field Event after their running event and be ready to compete.

Long Jump, Shot Put and Discus will be contested with three jumps or throws.
