All judges and officials must be current AAU members. If teams are unable to provide the minimum number of judges they may be unable to participate. Please refer to the AAU rulebook for judge requirements.

- 1. Team and Coach Info Worksheet: provide the required information for coach, coach of record, and support box people as indicated
- 2. Athlete and Event Entry Worksheet:
 - List name of each athlete competing and provide information requested in each column.
- 3. Judge and Volunteer Nomination Worksheet: provide names of available judges and volunteers. Teams are required to provide a minimum of 1 trained judge for every 4 athletes competing, additional judges are always helpful! A judge that is only available either as just a speed judge or just a freestyle judge will count as 0.5 judge. Non-judging volunteers are also needed to help with this event. We may need to limit registrations if we do not have enough judges and volunteers.
