ADMISSION: \$10.00pp, 2 SPECTATORS PER ATHLETE AT THIS TIME (WE WILL SEND AN UPDATE IF WE WILL ALLOW MORE OR LESS TO COME ACCORDING TO THE COVID NUMBERS ABOUT A WEEK BEFORE THE MEET)

TEAM FEE: **\$25.00 PER LEVEL** (3 to make a team XB, XS, XG placing top 3 teams, minimum of 2 teams per level) *XP & XD are allowed 2 athletes to make a team

AWARDS:

- TOP HALF + ONE MEDALS ON INDIVIDUAL EVENTS - ALL AROUND AWARDED 100%, TOP HALF TROPHIES BOTTOM HALF MEDALS

HIGH SCHOOL SENIORS: Please let me know if you have any seniors so we can leave time to recognize them in their session. Coaches will provide gifts for their senior.

Coaches & Judges Meals + Gifts: Meals will be served, please bring the appropriate amount of coaches to each session. Two coach's gifts per team will be given, if you have more than 2 coaches please email me in advance.

COVID POLICIES:
