- Date:** Sunday, March 9, 2025
- Location:** Billings Senior High School, 425 Grand Ave., Billings, MT; please park and enter on the north side of the building.
- Weigh-Ins:** Honor weigh-ins to be completed Thursday evening, March 6th. No on-site weigh-ins.
- Registration:** At www.trackwrestling.com. Search events for “2025 Darkhorse Invitational.” Girls **must register** in dedicated girls’ brackets. Accommodations / adjustments to weight classes will be made, if needed. Please make sure to register girls and boys on two separate teams (e.g., Darkhorse Boys, Darkhorse Girls).
- Entry Deadline:** **Friday, March 7th @ 10:00 P.M. Tournament capped at 750 participants.** If you have any questions about the registration process, please contact sreynolds@huntley.k12.mt.us or call Sarah Reynolds (406) 698-7665.
- Entry Fee:** \$10 per wrestler – Payable directly through registration at www.trackwrestling.com.
- Schedule:** **All scratches and double-bracket requests must be made with the Head Pairer, Sarah Reynolds, by 8:15 a.m. Wrestling begins at 9:15 a.m. for ALL age groups (we will be wrestling in two gyms).** Coaches/Officials meeting @ 8:30 a.m.
Table Workers meeting at 8:45 a.m.
- Requirements:** Each club will be required to provide 1 adult referee and 2 table workers. Fines will be assessed if not provided. Trackwrestling workers, please contact Sarah Reynolds prior to the tournament so she can ensure all tables will be covered.
- Admissions:** Adults: \$8 Students: \$5 Kids 5 & Under: Free
- Coaches:** \$10 for Coach’s Pass – proof of a current AAU card will be required
- Awards:** 1st Place individual trophies; 2nd – 6th Place medals; Team trophies for Sm., Med., Large
- Concessions:** Full concessions will be available all day. No coolers please.
- Sanction:** This event is licensed by the Amateur Athletic Union of the U.S., Inc. All participants must have a current AAU Membership. AAU membership may not be included as part of the entry fee to the event. AAU membership must be obtained before the competition begins except where the event operator has a laptop available with an internet connection. **BE PREPARED: Adult and Non-Athlete memberships are no longer instant and cannot be applied for at event. Please allow 10 days for membership to be processed.** Participants are encouraged to visit the AAU website www.aausports.org to obtain their membership.
