ELIGIBILITY:

This meet is open to any athlete that falls within the age divisions listed below. AAU individual and club memberships can be obtained through the AAU National Website <u>www.aausports.org</u>. Each athlete aged <u>13-18 years</u> may enter in up to a <u>maximum of 4 events</u>. Athletes aged <u>12 and</u> <u>younger</u> based on year of birth below may only enter in <u>3 events</u>. Athletes aged <u>19-Up years</u> <u>(OPEN & MASTERS)</u> may enter in up to a <u>maximum of 4 events</u>. If an athlete is entered into too many events, meet management reserves the right to reject the athlete from one or more events without notification.

*Athletes who are still eighteen (18) years of age through the final day (January 3rd) of the TRYON FIELD EVENTS INVITATIONAL shall be eligible to compete in the 17-18 year old division.



Meet Entry Fee:	Early Bird Entry fee is \$30.00 for each athlete (13-18) until February 17 th and will be <mark>\$40.00 for</mark>
	Track and Field Events until the Deadline February 21 st . All members of relay teams, including
	alternates, who have not entered an individual event, pay a Early Bird fee of \$30.00 until
	February 17 th and \$40.00 until the Deadline February 21st. ALL FEES ARE NON-REFUNDABLE
	AND NON-TRANSFERABLE. ALL ENTRY FEES MUST BE PAID ONLINE. Entry will not be Processed
	unless entry fee is paid by the deadline. All major credit cards accepted online.
Entry Process:	All teams and unattached athletes must utilize the online entry process via CoachO.com. This
	will permit a very efficient registration process that is easy to use. Immediately after registering
	online, you will receive a receipt from the website, which will produce a list of all athletes
	registered for the meet. This receipt should be used as your transcript of your meet entries. If
	your athletes do not appear on the confirmation, they are not registered for the meet. Please
	take care of these issues prior to arriving in Mill Springs, NC if possible.

When the Referee renders his/her decision, there is still the right of appeal to the Jury of Appeals. The jury's decision is final. If the protest is denied, the cash deposit will be forfeited. **PROTESTS CONCERNING JUDGMENT CALLS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.**
