**Requirement:** Everyone attending this clinic must have first completed steps 1-3 listed in the online course information page. The online course can be found on the AAU Taekwondo website (<https://aausports.org/taekwondo>) by going to “Officiating → Official’s Online Course. **Cost:** There is no cost for the clinic.

**Requirements:** Everyone attending the certification clinic must hold current 2025 non-membership. Anyone competing in an AAU event must also hold a 2025 athlete membership.

Everyone attending must have previously taken the online official's course. The cost of the course for officials is \$39. To take both the official's and coach's online course is \$99. Everyone attending this clinic MUST bring proof that the online course has been completed.

1. **All** officials' clinics **must** be done at the local level on a yearly basis.
2. All currently certified referees must attend a yearly local refresher clinic to keep their active status and to qualify to work at any of the current years' local or national events.
3. All referees must have current AAU membership. Apply for membership at [www.aausports.org](http://www.aausports.org).
4. All referees will be expected to dress in the proper attire when attending the District Qualifier. This currently is black slacks and an official's polo.
