Entry Fee: \$90 per Athlete (**due by Midnight February 21st 2022**).
\$10 Late Fee added ***if room allows*** (**applied February 22nd – March 21st, 2022**).
\$10 Level Change & Correction Fee for any changes made to a gymnast at any time of registration. ALL fees will be paid at time of registration.
** Team Fee: \$50 per team of 3 per level or more. **
** The per gymnast & Team INSIGHT user/registration fee is included as part of entry fee.

Registration will be open January 2nd – February 21st 2022

All coaches on the competition floor must be registered AAU Non-Athlete Members AND MUST ALSO REGISTER on Insight.scoreflippers.com Gymnasts and coaches must have their AAU membership prior to registering. Registration cannot be completed without a 2021-2022 AAU Membership.

*AAU membership may not be included as part of the meet entry fee.

Schedules: Scheduled will be available no later than April 3rd, 2022. Schedules will be sent to all registered clubs along with being posted on the INSIGHT link.

Refunds: No refunds unless canceled for pandemic reasons. If canceled for pandemic reasons refunds will be sent minus expenses already incurred such as administrative. (example: INSIGHT/ License fee, any items already purchased).
**Injury & Illness refunds must be received prior to the meet via email to aauwigymnastics@gmail.com with Doctor notes to receive partial refunds as listed above.

- Judges:** All Levels will be judged by NAWGJ Certified judges. High School level will be Judged by NHSF Certified Judges.
- AAU Levels:** High School Rules, Level 1 – Open Optional, & Ladies & All Xcel (Bronze, Silver, Gold, Platinum, Diamond) (High School National Rules will be used and gymnasts may be any age per AAU guidelines. (**WI is still a pilot for the High School rules and will not be available at Regionals or Nationals. If a gymnast competes in the HS session they can register for nationals in a suitable/comparable level**).
- Age Groups:** Age Divisions will be determined by # of entries in each level, not by a specific age spread. Gymnasts must be 4 yrs of age by the date of competition.
- Males:** If a male gymnast wishes to compete at the state meet, they may do so but will not compete against any females in any divisions and their scores will not be eligible for any team scores.
- Rules:** AAU National Rules – No District Modifications.
National High School Federation Rules – No District Modifications.

*All District State Award – Given to the highest All-Around score per level.

ALL GYMNASTS & COACHES ON COMPETITIVE FLOOR MUST BE AAU REGISTERED This event is licensed by the Amateur Athletic Union of the U.S., Inc. All participants must have a current AAU membership. AAU membership may not be included as part of the entry fee to the event. AAU Youth Athlete membership must be obtained before the competition begins. **BE PREPARED!** Adult and Non-Athlete memberships are no longer instant and cannot be applied for at event. Please allow at least 10 days for membership to be processed. Participants are encouraged to visit the AAU website: www.aausports.org to obtain their membership.

Judging Rules: This is not a USAG meet. AAU only follows USAG routine rules for guidelines. AAU follows USAG routines **with some changes**. Please see the AAU website for handbook rules at www.aausports.org. Go to publications for the gymnastics handbook. Please see that some routines are different than that of USAG. Wisconsin Does NOT change any routines from the AAU National rules allowed. We will use the National High School Federation Rules with no modifications. (No MAGA rules/modifications).
Please be sure to check the AAU Gymnastics National site for any differences.

Advancing to Regionals & Nationals = The WI District Championships will qualify gymnasts to the AAU Regionals & Nationals. Registration can be found at the national site www.aausports.org

Registration BEGINS January 2nd 2022 and will remain open with regular fee's until Monday February 21st, 2022 at midnight. Late registration will be open from February 22nd and remain open until Monday March 21st 2022 at midnight if room allows for additional gymnasts.

Some great things to know about this MEET GENIE:
Scoreflippers was the company that we had at the AAU 2019 & 2021 WI State & 2019 Regional Championships. If you attended these meets your Club will already be listed. If your gymnasts attended either of these meets they will already be listed also. You will just need to update their level/ and enter their new AAU Membership number. If you register them and do not change their level at time of registration you will be charged to change their level if you need to change it at a later date. **Always double check the spelling, level, and birthdate of your athletes.*

****You can also upload an INDIVIDUAL PHOTO of each gymnast to their registration. (This can also be done at a later time; this does not have to be done when registering). This photo will appear with their name on the scoring display monitor! And remember they will always have their scores in the system for any meets using the Scoreflippers scoring system!**
