- ADDITIONAL INFO:** Please note that for AAU Jump Rope Competition, one official must be provided for every 4 athletes competing from a team. Judges judging speed and freestyle events count as 1 judge. All judges and officials must be current AAU members.

- Teams are required to provide a minimum of 1 trained judge for every 4 athletes competing, additional judges are always helpful! A judge that is only available either as just a speed judge or just a freestyle judge will count as 0.5 judge. Non-judging volunteers are also needed to help with this event. We may need to limit registrations if we do not have enough judges and volunteers.
